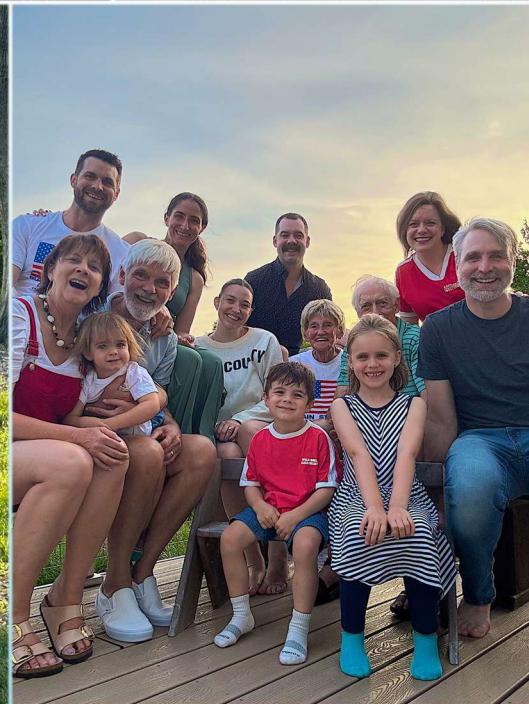
Our daughter is kind, curious, and always ready for a new adventure. She knows that every family is different, and is beyond excited at the idea of adding a new sibling into ours.
